The City of Fairbanks, Alaska is utilizing its Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) funding to **conserve energy, improve energy efficiency and reduce costs** by converting lighting in two main operating facilities to energy efficient LED lights.

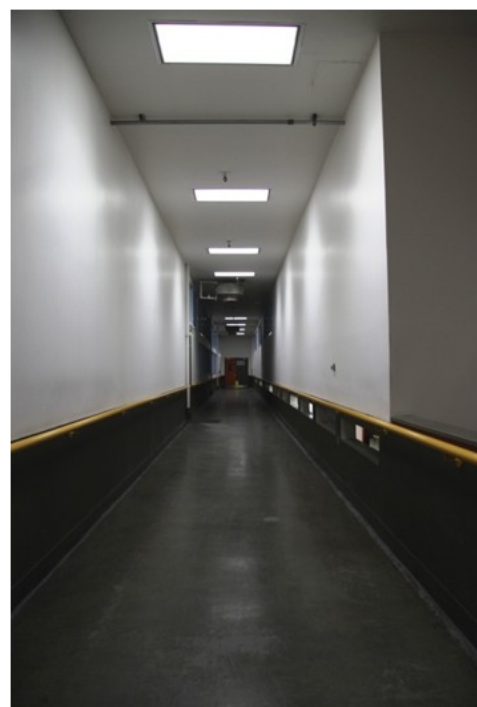
Fairbanks is using EECBG funding to ...

- Convert all interior fluorescent lighting in two main operating facilities to energy efficient LED lighting, **achieving an estimated 63% reduction in energy consumption.**

Impact on Fairbanks, AK

- \$164,100 in EECBG funding
- 2 FTE jobs created for installation
- \$44,000 anticipated savings
