Harrison County, Mississippi is utilizing its Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) funding to upgrade heating, ventilation and air conditioning (HVAC) units in County buildings to more energy-efficiency models. By doing so, Harrison County will **increase the life span of the units and save significant energy and utility costs over the years.**

Harrison County is using EECBG funding to ...

- **Replace obsolete HVAC units** at multiple county-owned buildings to improve efficiency, reduce operating costs and promote environmental awareness at the county level.
- **Improve insulation on HVAC duct work** to further enhance the efficiency of HVAC systems and reduce maintenance and down time.
