East Brunswick Promotes Sustainability Leadership

The Township of East Brunswick, New Jersey is utilizing its Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) funding **to help meet its commitments to the “Sustainable Jersey” program.** Sustainable Jersey is a certification program that recognizes municipalities willing to “go green” by taking measures that lower energy consumption, reduce greenhouse gas emissions and build vibrant and sustainable communities.

East Brunswick Township is using EECBG funding to ...

- **Replace 25 year-old high pressure sodium light fixtures in four municipal parking lots with state-of-the-art LED lighting,** helping decrease electrical use by an estimated 35-45%, and moving towards the Township’s goal of lowering its carbon footprint.

Impact on East Brunswick Township, NJ

- \$199,300 in EECBG funding
- 2 jobs to be created or retained
- 20.1 metric tons of CO2e emissions prevented
