Boulder City, Nevada is working to maximize the impact of its Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) funding. **Through the purchase and installation of high-efficiency induction street lamps, Boulder City continues to live up to its reputation as Clean Green Boulder City.**

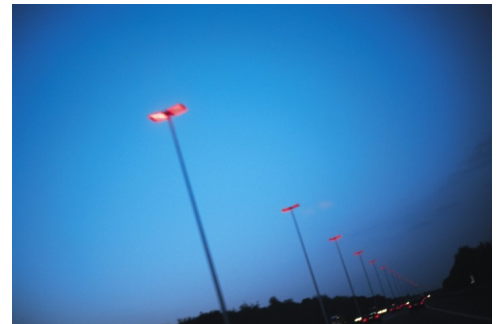
Boulder City is using EECBG funding to ...

- Reduce energy consumption by **replacing 100 street lights with induction lighting** that will put off the same amount of light as the current fixtures while using only half the energy.
- **Reduce maintenance and labor costs** by using lighting technology that has a longer bulb life.

Impact on Boulder City, NV

- \$61,600 in EECBG funding
- 200 megawatt-hours of energy saved over three years
