North Little Rock Lowers Utility Bills for Residents

The City of North Little Rock, Arkansas is investing its Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) funding to help save energy and lower utility bills for residents of North Little Rock. While working to save the community money and energy now, North Little Rock is also preparing for the future by commissioning studies that will enable the City to **take advantage of energy efficient lighting in municipal buildings, Smart Metering and Compressed Natural Gas (CNG) technologies.**

North Little Rock is using EECBG funding to ...

- Establish an “Efficiency Pays!” rebate program that will **provide rebates to homeowners and businesses** that purchase and install more energy efficient appliances, including HVAC systems, lighting and refrigerators.
- **Provide QuikSaver kits to North Little Rock residents**, each of which includes five compact fluorescent bulbs, one high-efficiency showerhead, six feet of pipe wrap, a kitchen aerator, bathroom aerator and educational information about energy efficiency.
- **Replace 200 municipal lights throughout North Little Rock with highly efficient induction or LED lighting** that will not only decrease energy usage, but also increase the functional lifetime of the streetlights.

Impact on North Little Rock, AR

- \$599,200 in EECBG funding
- 7 jobs to be created
- 3,664 metric tons of CO₂e emissions prevented
- Nearly \$350,000 in non-EECBG funding leveraged
