Norfolk Enhances its Green Community Efforts

The City of Norfolk, Virginia is utilizing its Energy Efficiency and Conservation Block Grant (EECBG) funding to **implement programs to reduce energy consumption in municipal buildings, promote community-wide home and small business energy efficiency, conservation and clean energy work.**

Norfolk is using EECBG funding to...

- **Audit 100 municipal buildings** – 3.5 million square feet of building area – and retrofit buildings with the greatest energy savings potential.
- Implement a Green Vision Community Energy Program in order to promote home and small business energy efficiency, conservation and clean energy by providing **funding for energy efficiency audits for homes and small businesses.**
- **Conduct energy efficiency and cooling tower upgrades** for the City's Central Energy Plant.

Impact on Norfolk, VA

- \$2,451,100 in EECBG funding
- 38 jobs to be created
- \$1 million in local funds leveraged
- \$80,000 saved annually in energy costs
- 19,026 metric tons of CO₂e emissions prevented
